





Patent for candle holder and dish for birthday cakes, 1901.




Patent for a robot amusement ride, 1958.







Patent for a toy horse, 1867.












Patent for saluting device, 1869.








Patent for submarine vessel, 1884.







COMBINED LOUNGE ROBE AND JACKET




